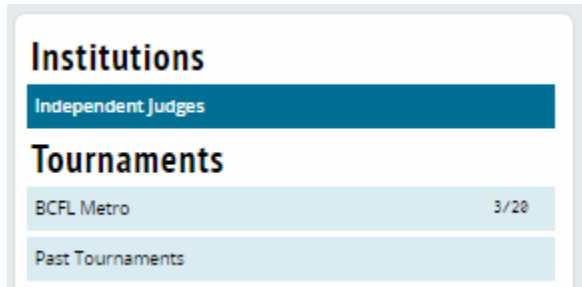

Log in using link in the upper right hand corner.

Select the tournament by clicking on the name.



You will see any currently assigned rounds listed. NOTE: Rounds are not all assigned at once. Please refer to the schedule for the approximate time each round or flight is stated to begin. Round assignments are typically posted approximately 15 minutes before the start time of the round.

If you registered a cell phone number when you set up your judge account, you will also get a text message letting you know when the next round is anticipated to begin and if you are assigned a round.

PLEASE DO NOT ASK IN ZOOM WHEN ROUNDS WILL BE POSTED.

Select "Current Ballots and Panels" to see rounds you are assigned. You will need to "refresh" your page in order for new assignments to appear.

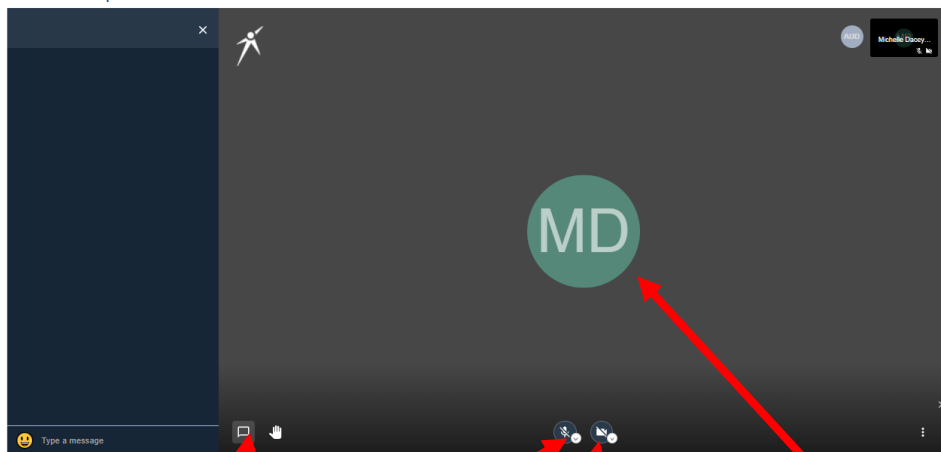
Competition/ Utility Room Features

The room name is found here



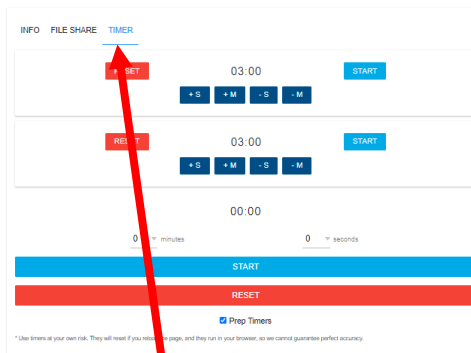
NSDA Campus - BQ 3

Microphone and Camera

Main Screen where Competitors and Judges will appear on camera



Timers (visible only to you)

Competitors must remain on camera for the duration of the round.

Judges are asked to leave their cameras on for the duration of the round. This is how competitors know you are still watching and there isn't a technology drop.

Judges should mute their microphones during competition.

BQ Round 2

We are all influenced by implicit bias, or the stereotypes that unconsciously affect our decisions. When judging, our implicit biases negatively impact students who are traditionally marginalized and disenfranchised. Before writing comments or making a decision, please take a moment to reflect on any biases that may impact your decision making process.

Resolution: Mathematics was discovered, not invented.

We are all influenced by implicit bias, or the stereotypes that unconsciously affect our decisions. When judging, our implicit biases negatively impact traditionally marginalized and disenfranchised students. Before writing comments or making a decision, please take a moment to reflect on any biases that may impact your decision making.

1. Because debaters cannot choose which side of the resolution to advocate, judges must be objective evaluators of both sides of the resolution. Evaluate the round based only on the arguments that the debaters made and not on personal opinions or on arguments you would have made.
2. Debaters may only make arguments directly related to the topic. When you sign your ballot, you are confirming that the winning debater ran a position about the topic. Debaters that run non-topical positions will be automatically forfeited.
3. Please fill out reasons why both sides may have won the debate in the space below. This technique is designed to force you to make the best possible case for both sides and help to eliminate bias in your decision. Your final decision for the winning debater should be filled in the boxes at the top of the ballot.


Anything written on this tab will be seen by both competitors and should justify why you voted for one side over the other.

Timers are for your use and can not be seen by competitors. It is recommended you use the top one for the total speech time allotted and the bottom two to track each side's prep time.


